It is hoped that the Partnership will be moving into the Park Hall in September of this year – this will include the two staff employed by the Partnership and the 2 members of the IDP team as well.

GVA Grimley have now completed the final report in respect of the Sites and Premises Development Framework studies. A copy of this can be seen in the Partnership office.

Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council have now started the consultation in respect of the Area Framework. This involves improving the facilities within Rawmarsh and Parkgate.

The Planning Day, held in Rosehill Park on the 19th April, was a great success. The table-top exercise and questionnaires have also been taken into local schools for the children to have their say. The information has now been collected together and will be evaluated over the next month or so.

The Community Tool Hire and Resource Shop, which is situated in the shopping centre in Bellows Road, is now open to the public.
