	 That an agenda item pertaining to Equalities be added to the Overview and Scrutiny Management Board agenda on a two-monthly basis.
	 That a fact-finding Equalities sub-group convene on a monthly or as-needed basis to discuss Equalities workstreams and lines of inquiry with a view to bringing outcomes to present at Overview and Scrutiny Management Board for further scrutiny.
	4. That the Equalities sub-group be comprised of a core group of Members with at least one member representing each of the scrutiny commissions, and that Members be invited to submit to this sub-group their questions or topics for discussion related to Equalities.
SEND Sufficiency Development Phase 3	 That Cabinet be advised that the recommendations be supported.
	2. That the Improving Lives Select Commission continues to monitor the implementation of the SEND Sufficiency Strategy
