(2) That no action be taken as a consequence of the review of the hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence in respect of Mr. R.R., but he be warned of the need to ensure his C.C.T.V. camera was operating effectively and that audio was used when transporting vulnerable people.

(3) That the hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence in respect of Mr. G.A. be revoked, but no action be taken as a consequence of the review of the private operator's licence.
