Last Month a survey was conducted by Councillor D. Hughes, Woodsetts Parish Council, Woodsetts Neighbourhood Watch and Community representatives from Rotherham 2010. The purpose of this survey was to attain the average figure to enable the use of the Calculation PV2 as used by RMBC to calculate if a pedestrian crossing on a given road was required. The survey was conducted on Worksop Road, Woodsetts.

After conducting the traffic survey and applying the average figures to the PV2 formula it was found that, using this formula, a pedestrian crossing was required.

Having already served this Council with a petition of over 700 signatures requesting a crossing, we therefore propose on the basis of these findings that this Council, as soon as can be possibly arranged, install a zebra crossing across Worksop Road, Woodsetts close to the crossroads with Dinnington Road, Lindrick Road and Gildingwells Road in accordance with this Council's own calculation and the wishes of nearly half the village population who signed the petition.
