Rotherham estates consultation

- Aim:

“To seek stakeholder views on the two preferred options within the estates transformation plans”



Part of wider consultation, 700 staff, service users, other stakeholders events.

Outcomes



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- Improved access for local people
- Aligned to GP surgeries
- Part of place based plans
- Integrated mental health, all age, LD services
- Town centre facility
- More efficient use of resources



Present estates

- Badsley Moore Lane- Learning disability services
- Ferham Clinic- Adult Mental Health
- Clifton Lane- IAPT
- Howarth House- OPMH and dementia clinics
- Swallownest Court- AMH inpatient/community
- Woodlands- OPMH inpatient

Proposed estates

- Swallownest court- South services
- Woodlands- Borough wide/front end services
- Clearways- Town Centre facility/clinics

Then:

North services

Option 4- BML (plus Ferham annex)

Option 5- Ferham (plus Ferham annex)

Buildings we will no longer require

- Reduce buildings from 6 to 4
- No longer require Clifton lane (IAPT)
- No longer require Howarth House (OPMH)
- Impact of agile working



Options considered

- Riverside (local authority building)
- The Bank
- Rawmarsh Health Centre
- Maintain Status Quo



Key messages:

- Best use of Rotherham pound
- Best value out of estates
- Reducing from 6 to 4 buildings
- Providing town centre clinic based services
- Services will continue to be delivered
