43. EXCLUSION OF THE PRESS AND PUBLIC

Resolved:- That, under Section 100A(4) of the Local Government Act 1972, the press and public be excluded from the meeting for the following item of business on the grounds that it involves the likely disclosure of exempt information as defined in the Police Act 1997 and Paragraphs 3 and 7 of Part I of Schedule 12A to the Local Government Act 1972 (business affairs and prevention of crime).

44. APPLICATIONS FOR THE GRANT/RENEWAL/REVIEW OF HACKNEY CARRIAGE/PRIVATE HIRE DRIVERS' LICENCES

The Sub-Committee of the Licensing Board considered a report of the Licensing Manager relating to applications for the review/renewal of hackney carriage/private hire drivers' licences in respect of Messrs. A.F., B.P., T.O.C. and N.S.

Messrs. B.P., T.O.C. and N.S., together with representatives, attended the meeting and were interviewed by the Sub-Committee.

Applicant Mr. A.F. had requested that his application for the review of a hackney carriage/private hire driver licence be deferred to enable him to seek legal advice.

Resolved:- (1) That consideration of the review of a hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence in respect of Mr. A.F. be deferred and he be afforded the opportunity of attending a future meeting of the Licensing Board Sub-Committee.

(2) That the application for a hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence in respect of Mr. B.P. be approved.

(3) That the private hire operator's licence in respect of Mr. T.O.C. be revoked.

(4) That, as a consequence of the review of the hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence in respect of the hackney carriage/private hire driver's licence in respect of Mr. N.S., he be suspended until such time as he satisfactorily completes a Safeguarding course, the details of which would be provided by the Council.
