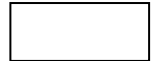

Cllr EH stated she had raised about situation with traffic control and restrictions at HWRC sites.</p> <p>Discussions were held around concerns with surge in demand at HWRC's, abuse of staff, traffic management, social distancing restrictions and expectations of the public once restrictions are eased. All agreed this a national issue and not just locally and the following actions were agreed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pull together communications jointly for public to ask them to follow social distancing guidance and enforce that staff should be treated with dignity and respect, abuse will not be tolerated • On behalf of South Yorkshire partnership, we ask questions of Defra around guidance and relaxing of restrictions and make it clear to the public we are following government guidelines

4.1	<p>SYWS Highlight Report - Copy attached.</p> <p>Cllr CL asked if anyone had anything to raise around the highlight report. All agreed nothing to raise.</p> <p>NB advised consultations for the resource and waste strategy are imminent and will be over a 3-month period.</p> <p>Cllr McG expressed his concerns over timescales of consultations during the election period around waste and recycling.</p> <p>BB these are government consultations, is nothing to do with the Hubbub work and agreed issue with timings had been raised.</p> <p>Cllr CL asked do we know whether Resource and Waste Strategy is intending to go through parliament and become an act?</p> <p>BB advised autumn is when the Environment Bill should be passed but not sure around Resource and Waste Strategy.</p> <p>NB advised the Environment Bill is due to go through in June and intention is to make regulations off the back of the consultations end of this year, start of next year.</p> <p>TS issues of timing of consultations was raised through Steering Committee, especially due to elections and engagement with members is a concern. Across S Y all have done a good job keeping HWRC's open and providing a service even with the restrictions in place.</p> <p>Cllr CL advised in BMBC they couldn't have expected any better a service given the difficult circumstances.</p>
