	SL outlined the potential requirements of the Board going forward, it is felt that the Town Deal Board will be needed for a further 12 months as full business cases are produced for the projects. This will have links with the Business Growth Board. A Task and Finish/Sub Group for each of the 6 projects will be established with a strong preference for members from this Board involved in each of them.	
	LV confirmed the role of this Board is to oversee procedures and make key decisions.	
	It was agreed a review of the way the Board functions be carried out, taking advantage of the skills set we have through to the 6 project groups.

11/21	Communications & Public Facing TIP	
	Smo commented on communications, there is a lot of new funding coming through, we must circulate positive news stories widely and change attitudes.	
	SL confirmed that the submitted TIP contained confidential information, therefore, a public facing version is currently being completed and will be available shortly, subject to Purdah and the local elections. This document will be made as widely available as possible.	
	PW commented on the wider communications and said promotion is very delicate in the bidding stage, we must be mindful of what and when we promote, but we should have something prepared, ready for the outcome. He added that the best comms in this, are the Board Members, spreading the word via social media and combating any negativity.	
	AD agreed that comms is the key, people need to see that things happening, and regeneration delivered.	
	The recent local stories implying the bid had been unsuccessful were mentioned, would be good to have local media on board for such a positive story. It was felt that when any monies are announced the good
