Dear Sir/Madam,

Proposed implementation of 20mph speed limit at West Melton, Rotherham.

I write to inform you that the Council as Highway Authority proposes to promote a traffic regulation order (TRO) the effect of which would be the implementation of a 20mph speed limit on the roads shown in the table below:

Albert Road	Barnsley Road (Service road only – Full length)	Blake Avenue

Details of this scheme are shown on drawing number: 122/21643/HT/04 which is attached.

The scheme itself will not include any physical traffic calming measures, such as road humps, at this time, as the main intention behind the proposals is to introduce a 20mph speed limit without the need for physical alterations to the road network. However, measures will be introduced at each entry point to the scheme, through changes to the speed limit signage, red coloured carriageway surfacing and speed limit roundels. Along the roads affected 20mph repeater signs will be installed. If you have any queries regarding this scheme, please do not hesitate to contact us by one of the methods available at the top of this letter.

This has been developed following suggestions made by your local Councillors to the Local Neighbourhood Road Safety Scheme Fund which has been set up in Rotherham to address community concerns. In this case the residential roads are frequently used by pedestrians accessing nearby local facilities, schools and for leisure purposes. It will also better reflect and indicate to users the speed at which it is safer to travel throughout this residential area.

The Traffic Regulation Order for the restrictions will be advertised by Notice in the local press and on site shortly. Formal objections to any aspect of this scheme will be required in writing to Legal Services at the address below (quoting reference NF/70383, or email: **Legal-TRO@rotherham.gov.uk**) no later than 27th August 2023. Any objections must specify the grounds on which they are being made.

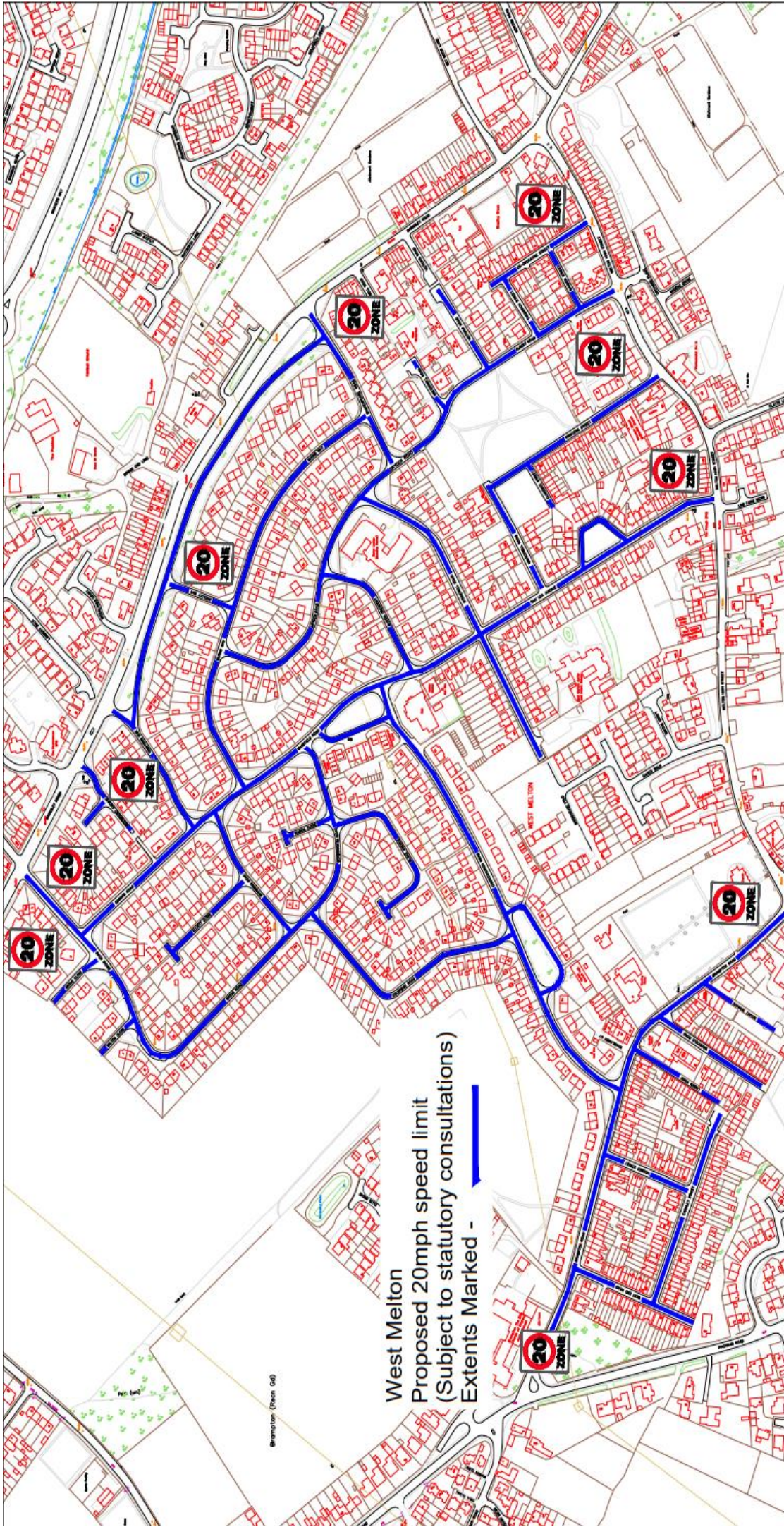
