

NOTICE OF REVOCATION OF THE AIR QUALITY MANAGEMENT AREA

MANAGEMENT AREA) REVOCATION ORDER 2024

Notice is hereby given that on the 13th day of May 2024 the Rotherham Borough Council propose to revoke "The Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area Fitzwilliam Road Nitrogen Dioxide (hourly mean) under Section 83 of the Environment Act 1995 (hereinafter called "the Act"). The Revocation of the Order comes into operation on the 13th day of May 2024 and the effect of the Revocation of the Order is to revoke the Air Quality Management Area described in the Schedule below in accordance with the provisions of the Act.

The Schedule

“Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide)–Fitzwilliam Road” is that area of land situated within the following boundary:

From St Ann’s roundabout along Fitzwilliam Road to the junction with Eldon Road. Follow the route of Eldon Road and then Chesterton Road in a general easterly direction to Sycamore Road. Follow Sycamore Road to Mushroom roundabout (A630/A6123). From the roundabout, follow Doncaster Road in a generally westerly direction until the junction with St Ann’s Road is reached. Follow St Ann’s Road in a northerly direction along St Ann’s Road to St Ann’s roundabout. Area shaded red on the map.
