REVOCATION ORDER 2024

Rotherham Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 83(2)(b) of the Environment Act 1995 HEREBY makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the “Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area Fitzwilliam Road Nitrogen Dioxide (hourly mean) Revocation Order 2024”.
2. The effect of the Order is to revoke as an Air Quality Management Area the area described in the Schedule hereto with respect to the [nitrogen dioxide (hourly)] objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2010.
3. The Revocation Order comes into operation on the 13th day of May 2024.

THE SCHEDULE

Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide)–Fitzwilliam Road” is that area of land situated within the following boundary:

From St Ann’s roundabout along Fitzwilliam Road to the junction with Eldon Road. Follow the route of Eldon Road and then Chesterton Road in a general easterly direction to Sycamore Road. Follow Sycamore Road to Mushroom roundabout (A630/A6123). From the roundabout, follow Doncaster Road in a generally westerly direction until the junction with St Ann’s Road is reached. Follow St Ann’s Road in a northerly direction along St Ann’s Road to St Ann’s roundabout. The area shaded red on the map.
