## THE SCHEDULE

Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area (Nitrogen Dioxide)—Fitzwilliam Road" is that area of land situated within the following boundary:

From St Ann's roundabout along Fitzwilliam Road to the junction with Eldon Road. Follow the route of Eldon Road and then Chesterton Road in a general easterly direction to Sycamore Road. Follow Sycamore Road to Mushroom roundabout (A630/A6123). From the roundabout, follow Doncaster Road in a generally westerly direction until the junction with St Ann's Road is reached. Follow St Ann's Road in a northerly direction along St Ann's Road to St Ann's roundabout. The area shaded red on the map.
