

Road Hump notice

**ROTHERHAM METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL
(HARD LANE AND THORPE ROAD, WOODALL LANE AND KILLAMARSH LANE,
HARTHILL AND WOODALL)
CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS**

Notice is hereby given that Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council (RMBC), acting as the local highway authority, proposes to construct in accordance with its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and all other enabling powers, road humps on the roads listed in the Schedule to this Notice. The nature and dimensions of the road humps are also specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The construction of road humps is associated with Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council's Local Neighbourhood and Road Safety Programme. This programme is intended to address concerns in the community in respect of the operation of the highway network, whilst also contributing to strategic objectives, of improving road safety and reducing vehicle speeds through Harthill and Woodall.

Objections to the proposal to construct the road humps at the locations specified and other representations can be sent to the address below (quoting reference 033E-WW-H,W-RP) and must be received no later than the **10th day of November 2023**. All objections and other representations must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.

Schedule

Hard Lane, approximately 35 metres north of Northlands	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
Hard Lane, approximately 40 metres south of Northlands	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
Thorpe Road near property number 15	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
Thorpe Road near property number 31	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
Woodall Lane, approximately	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with

55 metres east of Dowcarr Lane

a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.

Killamarsh Lane, approximately
35 metres west of Walseker

60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with
a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
