Proposed implementation of 20mph speed limit zone – Woodall Village, Rotherham

I write to inform you that Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council, as Highway Authority, proposes to promote a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO), the effect of which would be the implementation of a 20mph speed limit in Woodall Village, on all roads highlighted in the attached drawing reference number: 126/18/TT785.

This scheme has been developed from submissions made by your local ward Councillors and residents following the proposals set out in the consultation letter I sent out last June, which were in turn based on submissions previously received for road safety and traffic management improvements in the area to address highway issues and community concerns. The lower speed limit will also better reflect and indicate to users, the speed at which it is safer to travel at, given that the roads are residential in nature and frequently used by pedestrians.

The scheme itself will also include traffic calming measures with improved village entry points, red coloured carriageway surfacing and speed limit carriageway roundels along with 20mph repeater signs and some additional warning signs.

A TRO for the 20mph speed limit will be advertised in the local press and on site shortly. Formal objections to any aspect of this scheme will be required in writing to Legal and Democratic Services at the address below (or email: Legal-TRO@rotherham.gov.uk) no later than 15th March 2024. Any objections must specify the grounds on which they are being made.
