Dear Councillor,

Proposed implementation of North and South residential 20mph speed limit zones – Woodsetts Village, Rotherham

I write to inform you that Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council, as Highway Authority, proposes to promote a Traffic Regulation Order (TRO), the effect of which would be the implementation of 2 speed limit reduction schemes in the urban areas of Woodsetts and includes the area around Woodsetts Primary school and includes Lindrick Road. The proposed schemes are shown on the attached drawings, referenced 126/46/TT113 and 126/46/TT112.

These schemes have been developed a result of correspondence and submissions received by residents and yourselves as local ward members, to address matters in the area as part of the Local Neighbourhood Road Safety Scheme. The proposals reflect that the areas are residential in nature and used by pedestrians. The lower speed limit will better indicate to users, the speed at which it is safe to travel, and will include the introduction of 20mph speed limit entry points to the estates including red coloured surfacing and speed limit carriageway roundels along with 20mph repeater signs and some additional warning signs.

The proposals shown on the attached drawing are currently being considered by statutory consultees, for example, the emergency services, who will respond within one month. If you have any concerns, I should be grateful if you would respond within one month of the date of this letter to ensure the implementation is not unduly delayed.

Details of the TRO and associated schemes will be sent to resident in Woodsetts and advertised on site and in the local press shortly to increase awareness of the scheme. Should no objections be received in respect of this Order, we will be looking to undertake the works on site later this year.
