

# Road Hump notice

## ROTHERHAM METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL (DINNINGTON ROAD, WORKSOP ROAD AND GILDINGWELLS ROAD, WOODSETTS) CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS

Notice is hereby given that Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council (RMBC), acting as the local highway authority, proposes to construct in accordance with its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 and all other enabling powers, road humps on the roads listed in the Schedule to this Notice. The nature and dimensions of the road humps are also specified in the Schedule to this Notice.

The construction of road humps is associated with Rotherham Metropolitan Borough Council's Local Neighbourhood and Road Safety Programme. This programme is intended to address concerns in the community in respect of the operation of the highway network, whilst also contributing to strategic objectives, of improving road safety and reducing vehicle speeds through Harthill and Woodall.

Objections to the proposal to construct the road humps at the locations specified and other representations can be sent to the address below (quoting reference 126-18-TT787) and must be received no later than the **26th day of January 2024**. All objections and other representations must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.

### Schedule

Dinnington Road, near property no 15	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with Set of 2, 60mm high channelled flat topped road cushions with a 0.7-metre-long plateau and 0.6-metre-long ramps.
Worksop Road, near property no 25	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
Worksop Road, approx 12 metres South East of Grange Avenue	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
Gildingwells Road, near property no 138	60mm high channelled flat topped road hump with a 5-metre-long plateau and 1-metre-long ramps.
