




Summary of responses to RMBC's consultation on admission arrangements for community and voluntary controlled schools

Question 1 asked 'Do you agree with the proposed relevant area remaining as the whole of the borough of Rotherham?'

14 responses were received

- 13 respondents answered 'yes'
- 1 respondent answered 'no'



The respondent who did not agree provided a comment in relation to the admission arrangements and not the relevant area.

One comment was received from respondents agreeing with the proposal 'The relevant area as a whole should continue to mirror the whole borough boundary, unless there are exceptional reasons to alter this.'

Question 2 asked 'If there are any further comments you would like to make about the proposed admission arrangements for 2026-27.'

3 comments were received, two in support of the arrangements and one raising a query about the catchment area for Oakwood High School. As Oakwood is part of the Inspire Learning Trust, RMBC is not the admission Authority for the school and as such the catchment area does not form part of RMBC's admission arrangements.

- 'Why is Whiston not in the catchment for Oakwood High School? This has caused all sorts of problems for our children.'
- 'The proposals continue to offer a fair and clear explanation of the admission policy, in line with statutory requirements.'
- 'The arrangements seem fair.'
