**REVOCATION ORDER 2025**

Rotherham Borough Council, in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 83(2)(b) of the Environment Act 1995 HEREBY makes the following order:

1. This order may be cited as the “Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area Wortley Road Nitrogen Dioxide (annual mean) Revocation Order 2025”
2. The Revocation Order comes into operation on the **1<sup>st</sup> day of June 2025** and the effect of the Order is to revoke the Air Quality Management Area described in the Schedule hereto with respect to the [nitrogen dioxide (annual mean)] objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2010 in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Council by Section 83 of the Environment Act 1995.

**3. THE SCHEDULE**

“Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area– Wortley Road” is that area of land situate within the following boundary:

From the roundabout at the junction of Wortley Road and Wilton Gardens, follow Wilton Gardens in a southerly direction to the junction with Church Street. Follow Church Street in a generally westerly direction to the junction with High Street. Follow High Street in a north westerly direction to the junction with Old Wortley Road. Follow Old Wortley Road in a general northerly direction to Wortley Road. Follow Great Park Road in a north easterly direction to the junction with Eilam Road. Follow Eilam Road and Eilam Close, then follow Watson Road in a south easterly direction to Bradgate Road. Follow Bradgate Road to the roundabout of Wortley Road (A629) and Wilton Gardens.
