Harthill, various roads - Proposed waiting restrictions

As part of our ongoing commitment to improving road safety within the borough we are looking to introduce a series of waiting restrictions in Harthill.

Following discussions with local ward councillors, initial proposals were drawn up and an informal consultation took place in June 2023, following feedback from residents' the double yellow line, waiting restriction proposals were reviewed and adjusted to include additional measures along Hard Lane, Union Street and adjoining side roads in Harthill.

This project covers and has been developed as part of the borough wide project strategy being rolled out under the Local Neighbourhood Road Safety Scheme Fund.

These restrictions should provide organised parking and passing locations along this road, especially the local bus service which travels along this road, thus removing the inappropriate parking in the area and on footways which should assist with the safe and free flow of traffic in the village. In addition, the measures to deter parking on footways in Harthill will help facilitate travel by footways (by providing for this positively on the carriageway) will contribute to the objective of decarbonising travel by supporting travel by low carbon means. The proposed scheme is shown on the attached drawing, 126/18/TT784.

The Traffic Regulation Order for these restrictions will be advertised by Notice in the local press and on site. Objections to the proposed Order and other representations relating to it can be sent to Transportation Infrastructure Service at the address shown below or by using the email address at the top of this letter and must be received no later than the 10th November 2024. All objections and other representations must be made in writing and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
