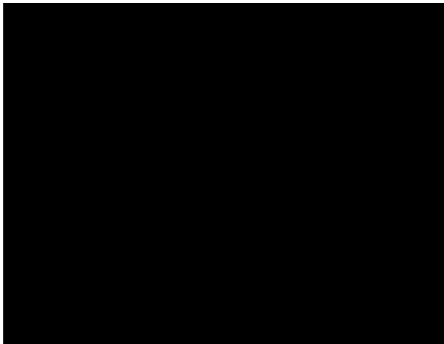

Please find enclosed a petition signed by residents and visitors to Melton Green regarding traffic issues on our road. We asked whether they would prefer the installation of speed humps to address the ongoing problems of vehicle speed and noise—and the overwhelming majority were eager to sign, many providing personal reasons for their support.

Numerous signatories praised the success of speed restrictions on Racecourse Road in Wath and expressed that similar measures would now be the preferred solution for Melton Green.

As shown in the enclosed newsletter, various traffic-calming options have been considered in the past. However, given the persistent issues, we believe that speed humps—comparable to those on Racecourse Road—are now the only viable option.

Over the past five years, residents have made continuous efforts, including requests, meetings, and the implementation of different speed signs. These efforts have been met with support and compliments from the community, who continue to ask for updates. The urgency of this matter has increased due to the surrounding housing developments and traffic diversions, which have turned Melton Green into a viable rat run, especially as it is one of the straightest and clearest roads in the area.

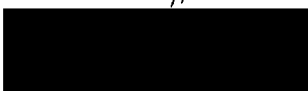
It's also worth highlighting the vulnerability of many residents: a significant number are elderly, and there are at least four homes with disabled children or young adults, including individuals who are visually impaired.
