THE PREMISES SHALL CONTINUE TO OPERATE IN ACCORDANCE WITH ALL EXISTING LICENCE CONDITIONS AND MANAGEMENT PRACTICES. CCTV COVERS THE EXTERNAL SEATING AREA WITH RECORDINGS RETAINED INLINE WITH EXISTING LICENCE CONDITIONS.

ALCOHOL WILL ONLY BE SOLD TO SEATED CUSTOMERS, AND NO OPEN CONTAINERS WILL BE PERMITTED TO LEAVE THE LICENSED AREA. ANY INCIDENTS WILL BE LOGGED AND DEALT WITH PROMPTLY BY MANAGEMENT.

c) Public safety

THE OUTDOOR AREA IS CLEARLY DEFINED AND FURNISHED WITH SAFE, STABLE FURNITURE.

ACCESS AND EXIT ROUTES WILL BE KEPT CLEAR AT ALL TIMES. STAFF WILL MONITOR THE AREA TO ENSURE IT DOES NOT BECOME OVERCROWDED.
