Brecks Lane – Proposed waiting restrictions

As part of our ongoing commitment to improving road safety within the borough we are looking to introduce a series of waiting restrictions (double yellow lines) on Brecks Lane, Rotherham.

Following discussions with Local Ward Members in July 2025, initial proposals have been drawn up and the proposed scheme can be seen on the attached drawing, 126/17/TT563a.

These restrictions should provide organised parking along this road and protect the junction with Bawtry Road preventing motorists from parking on or close to the junction.


In accordance with the Local Authorities Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996, I should appreciate it if you would confirm within one month of the date of this letter that you have no objections to the proposals as shown on drawing 126/17/TT563a.

The Traffic Regulation Order for these restrictions will be advertised by Notice in the local press and on site. Objections to the proposed Order and other representations relating to it can be sent to Transportation Infrastructure Service at the address shown below or by using the email address at the top of this letter and must be received no later than the **24th October 2025**. All objections and other representations must be made in writing, and all objections must specify the grounds on which they are made.
