Reasons for the Decision:	To encourage use of the car park by genuine customers of Forge Island car park and deterring prolific use by non-customers.
Details of alternative options considered and rejected:	<p>Option 1 – Retain the current tariff as per the 2025/26 “fees and charges” decision</p> <p>This was not deemed to be viable because if the current tariff for Forge Island car park were to be reintroduced, it is highly likely that much of the parking capacity would be used by commuters, rather than customers of the businesses.</p> <p>Option 3 – Offer no further concessions but introduce a new tariff.</p> <p>This option was not deemed to be favourable as the decision was taken to offer concessions to the other businesses.</p>
