The Plan has been approved by Cabinet and the Neighbourhood Board therefore this decision is likely to be approved.</p> <p>It is recommended that the Council, in partnership with the Neighbourhood Board, submits Rotherham's PiP Phase 1 Regeneration Plan to Government in November, to bring forward a long-term programme of interventions that will deliver positive outputs for local people.</p>
Details of alternative options considered and rejected:	The Council could choose not to pursue this grant funding opportunity however, the consultation and area data suggests that the proposed interventions are critical to addressing local need. This option is therefore not recommended.
