

List of schemes to be funded under the Minor Works programme

2026/27

Revocation of obsolete disabled parking bays - £6,725

Funding is allocated for the revocation of existing Designated Disabled Persons' Parking Bays, where no longer required, and the provision of new bays in response to applications from residents.

Locations will be based on applications received by the Transportation Unit. Initial indications suggest that funding will allow for approximately 6 markings, including processing of the Traffic Regulation Order.

Implementation of advisory disabled parking bays £9,058

Locations will be determined based on applications received by the Transportation Unit. Eligible requests will be prioritised on a first-come basis until funding is exhausted, with current estimates indicating provision for approximately 18 markings.

Implementation of advisory driveway markings (H markings) - £8,695

Locations will be based on applications received by the Transportation Unit. Eligible applications will be prioritised on a first-come, first-served basis until the allocated funding is exhausted. Initial indications suggest that funding will allow for approximately 18 markings.

Capital maintenance of vehicle activated signs - £6,885

Identified location: Main Street, Aughton.

Removal or improvement of deprecated access barriers - £22,950

Identified location: Green Lane, Moorgate – implementation of staggered barrier to prevent quad bikes and motorcycles cutting through.

Bollards or similar to deter footway or verge parking - £26,520

Identified locations for waiting restrictions and bollards.

- Lowfield and Highfield Junctions with Potter Hill, Greasbrough – waiting restrictions (double yellow lines).
- Morthen Road, Wickersley – waiting restrictions (double yellow lines).
- Yeoman's way South Anston, 4 bollards to prevent footway parking.
- Penny Hill Lane, Ulley, verge marker posts.
