REVOCATION ORDER NOTICE

1. Notice is hereby given that on the 31st day of July 2026 the Rotherham Borough Council propose to revoke the “Rotherham Borough Council Fitzwilliam Road Air Quality Management Area Nitrogen Dioxide (annual mean) Order 2004”. This order may be cited as the “Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area Fitzwilliam Road Nitrogen Dioxide (annual mean) Revocation Order 2026”
2. The Revocation Order comes into operation on the 11th day of September 2026 and the effect of the Order is to revoke the Air Quality Management Area described in the Schedule hereto with respect to the [nitrogen dioxide (annual mean)] objective as specified in the Air Quality Regulations 2010 in exercise of the powers conferred upon the Council by Section 83 of the Environment Act 1995.

3. THE SCHEDULE

“Rotherham Borough Council Air Quality Management Area– Fitzwilliam Road” is that area of land situate within the following boundary:

From St Ann’s roundabout along Fitzwilliam Road to the junction with Eldon Road. Follow the route of Eldon Road and then Chesterton Road in a general easterly direction to Sycamore Road. Follow Sycamore Road to Mushroom roundabout (A630/A6123). From the roundabout, follow Doncaster Road in a generally westerly direction until the junction with St Ann’s Road is reached. Follow St Ann’s Road in a northerly direction along St Ann’s Road to St Ann’s roundabout.
