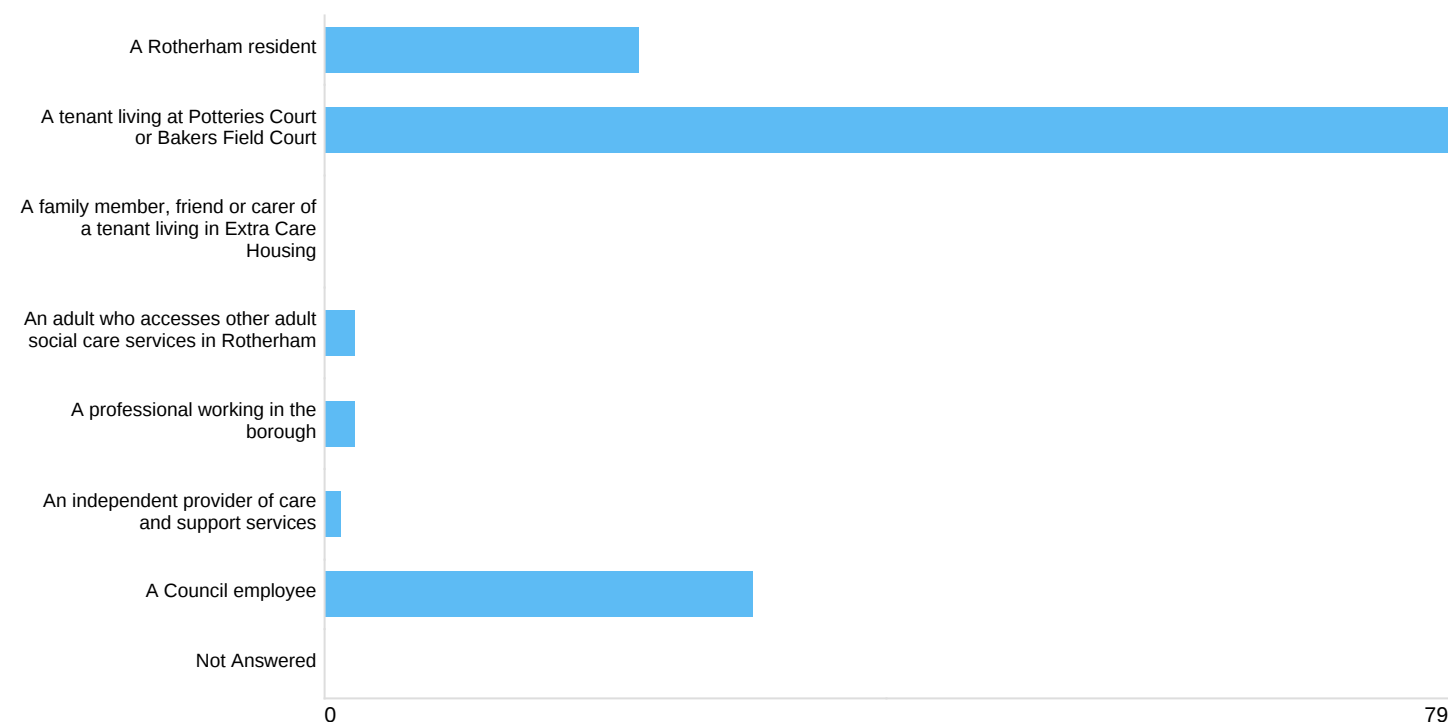

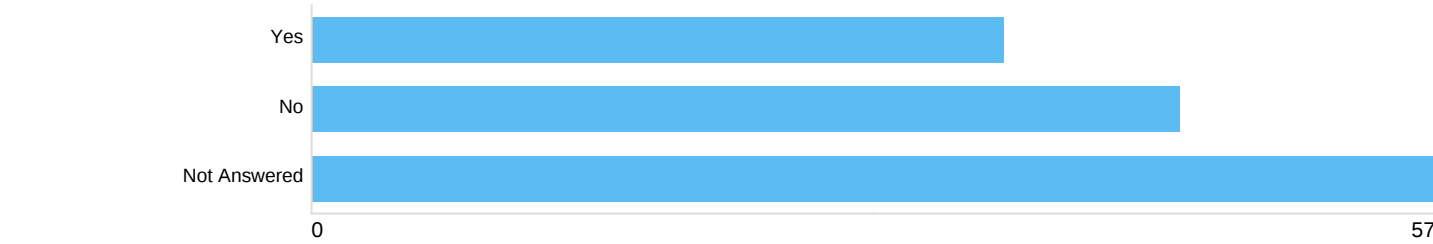

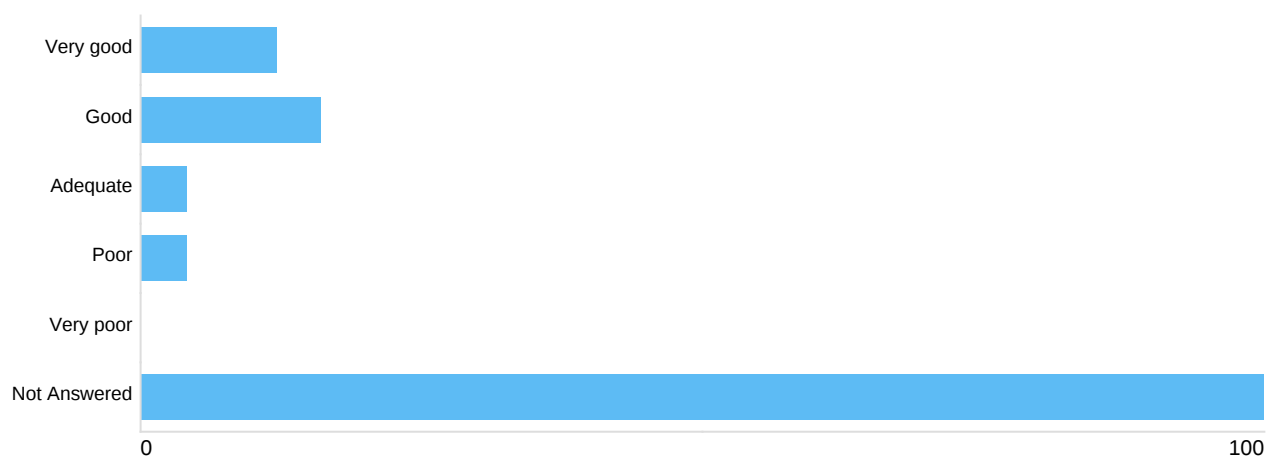
receiving personal care

How would you describe the quality of your current care and support from this provider?

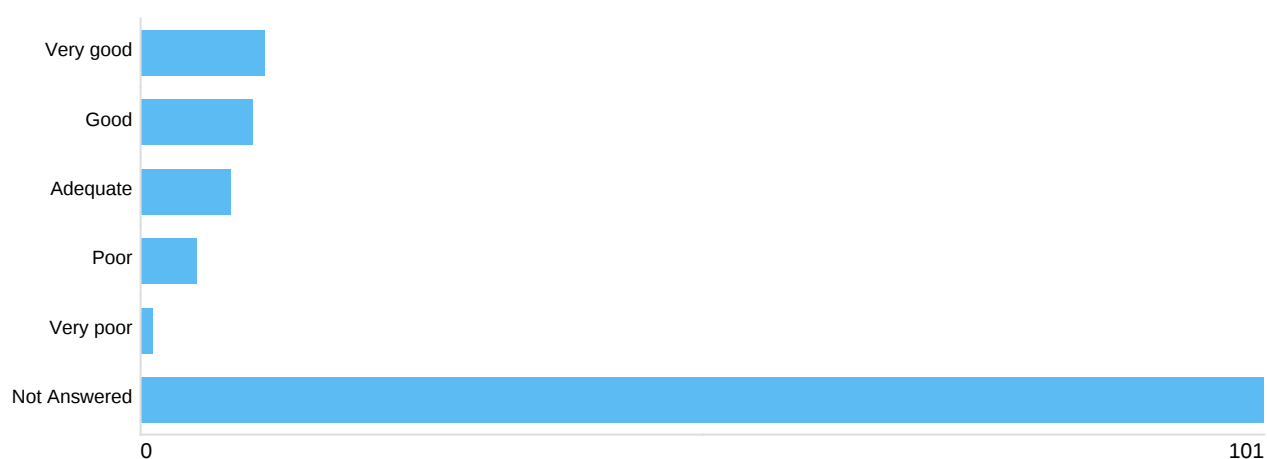
quality of current care

How would you describe the timeliness of your current care and support from this provider?

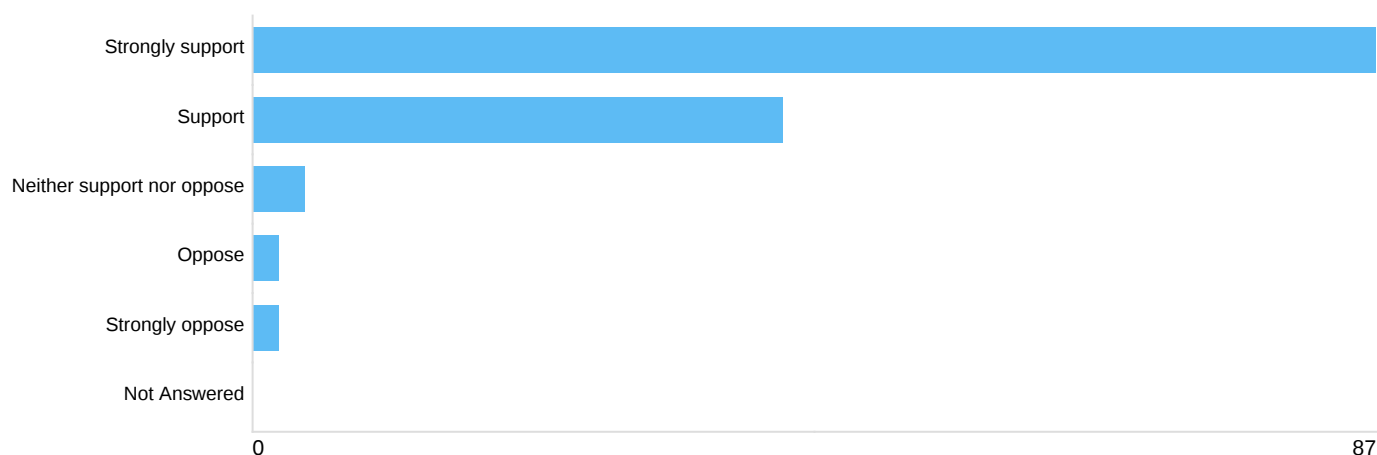

Overall, to what extent do you support the model described?

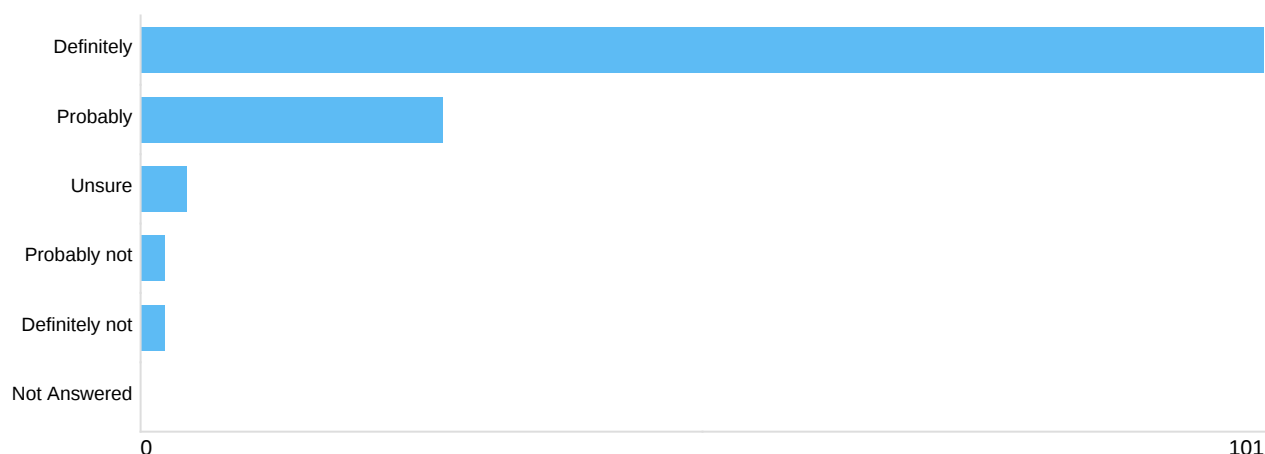
overall experience

Do you think this model could improve the overall experience for tenants living in Extra Care Housing?

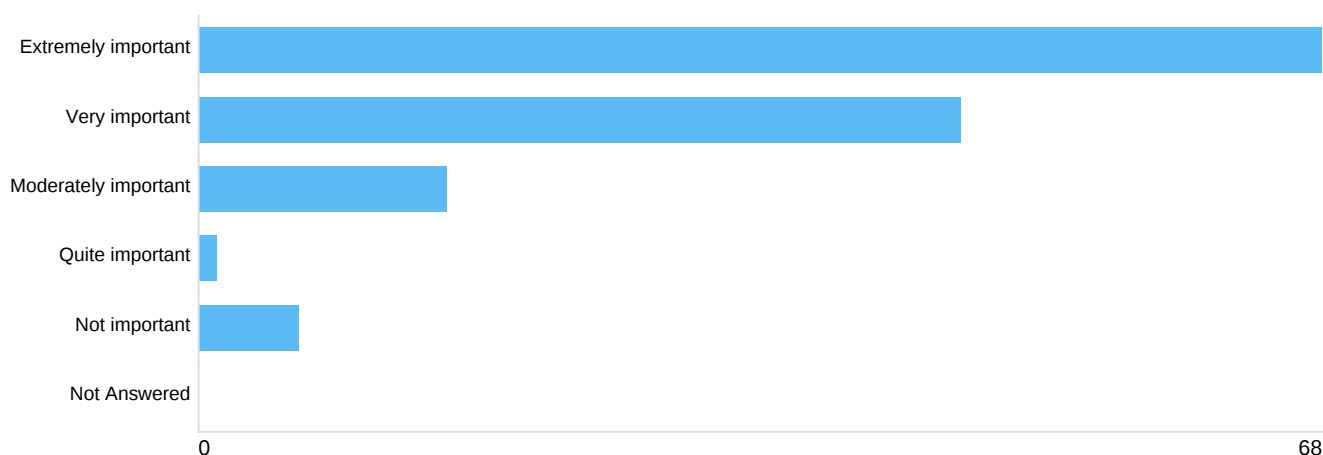
overall tenant experience

How important is it to you that one team of Council-employed staff deliver care and support to meet tenant need?

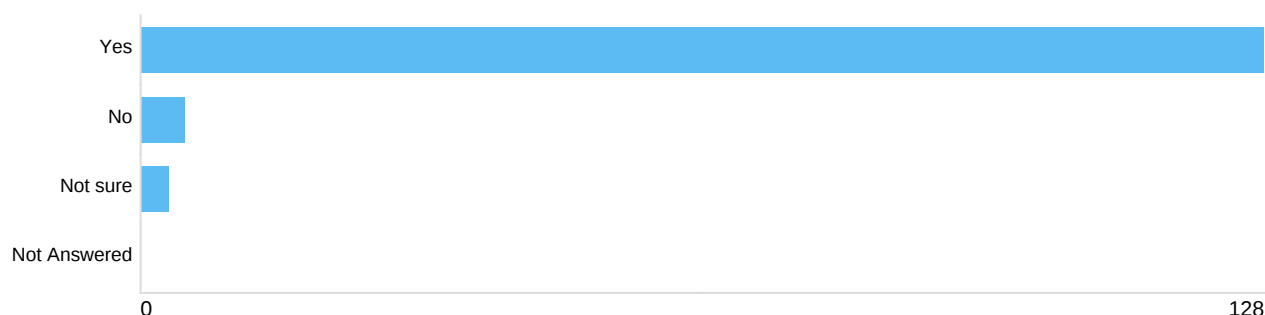

24/7 availability on site



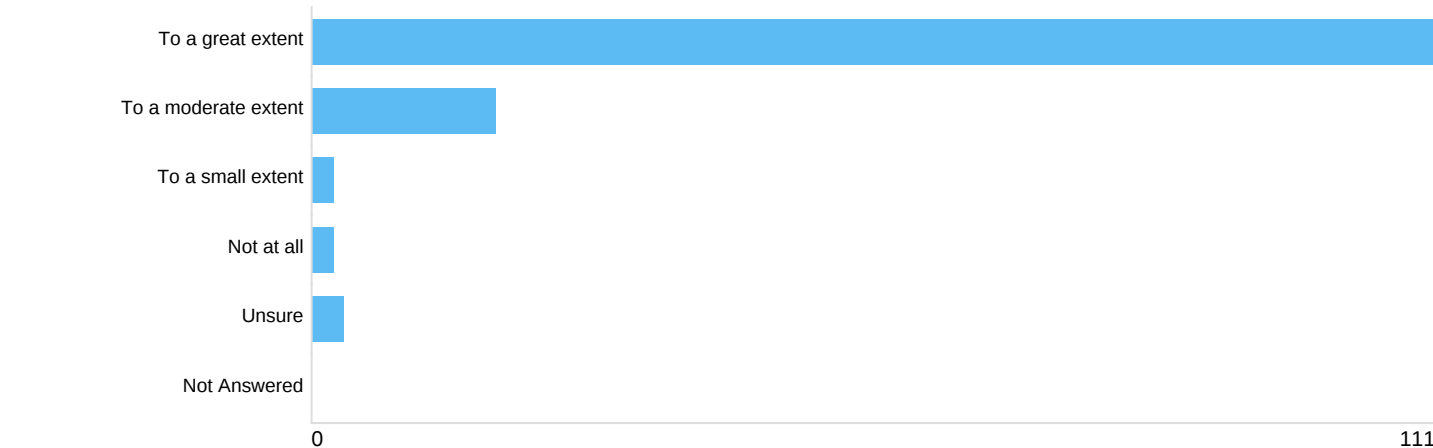

To what extent do you think staff being based on-site 24/7 could improve outcomes for tenants?

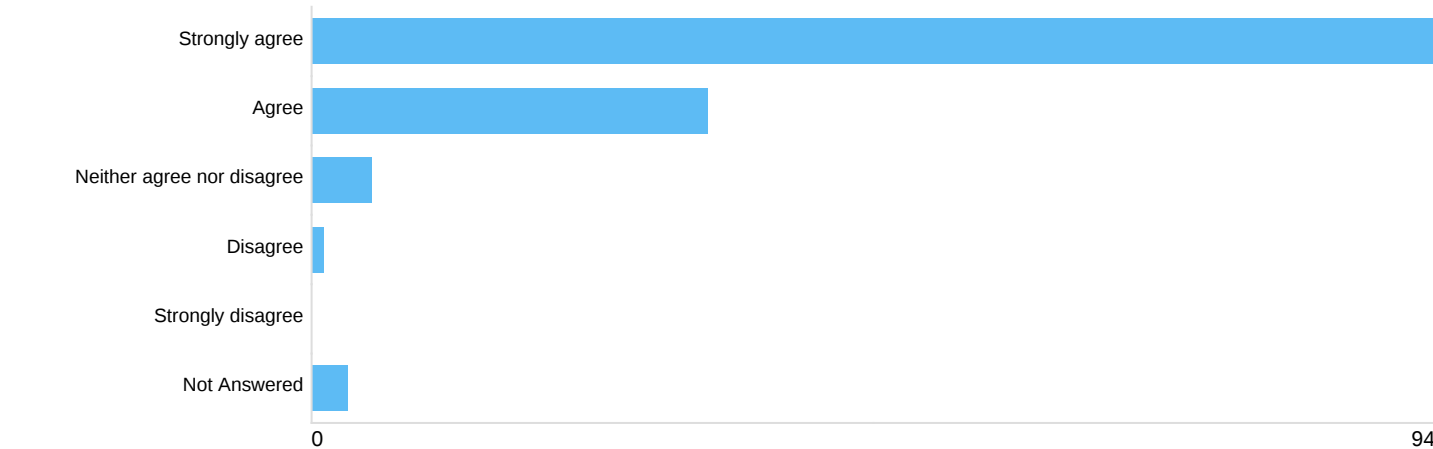
24/7 availability

To what extent do you agree that an enabling approach could support people to remain independent for longer?

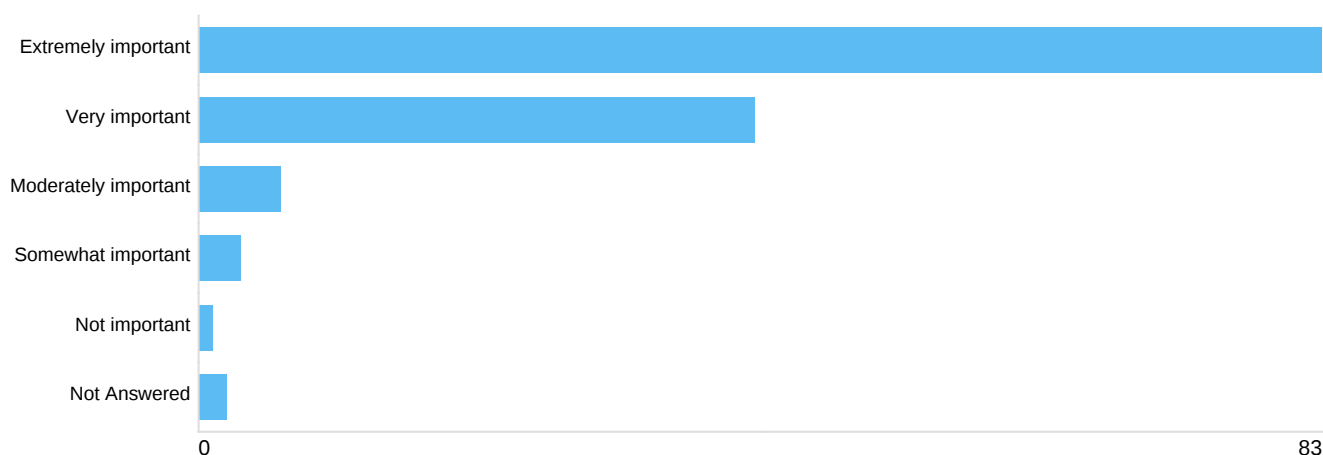

How important is it that housing related support is provided by the Council?

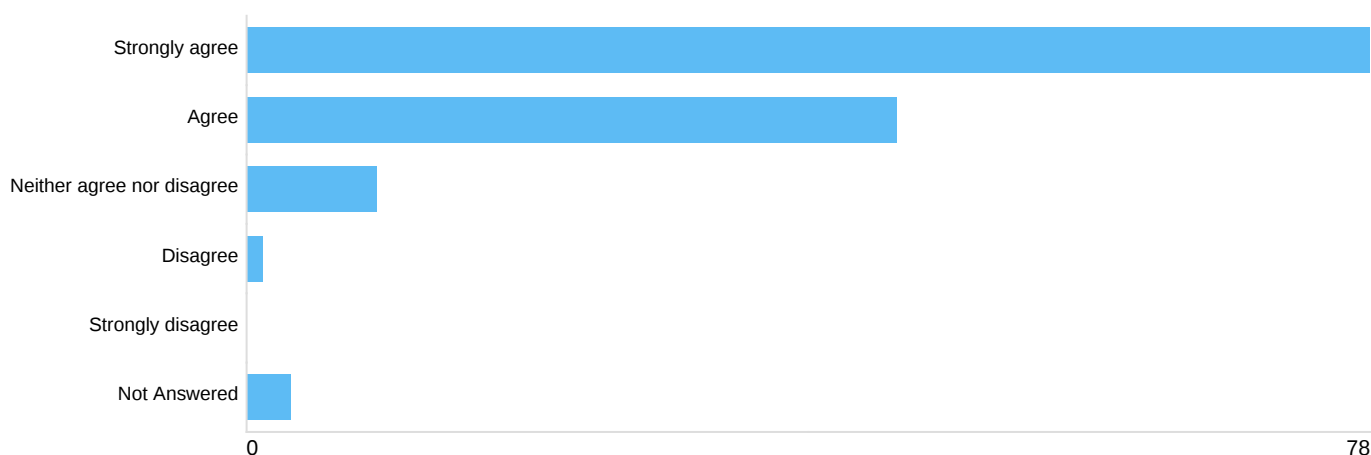

Do you agree that registering Extra Care Housing with the Care Quality Commission will support the service to provide high quality care?

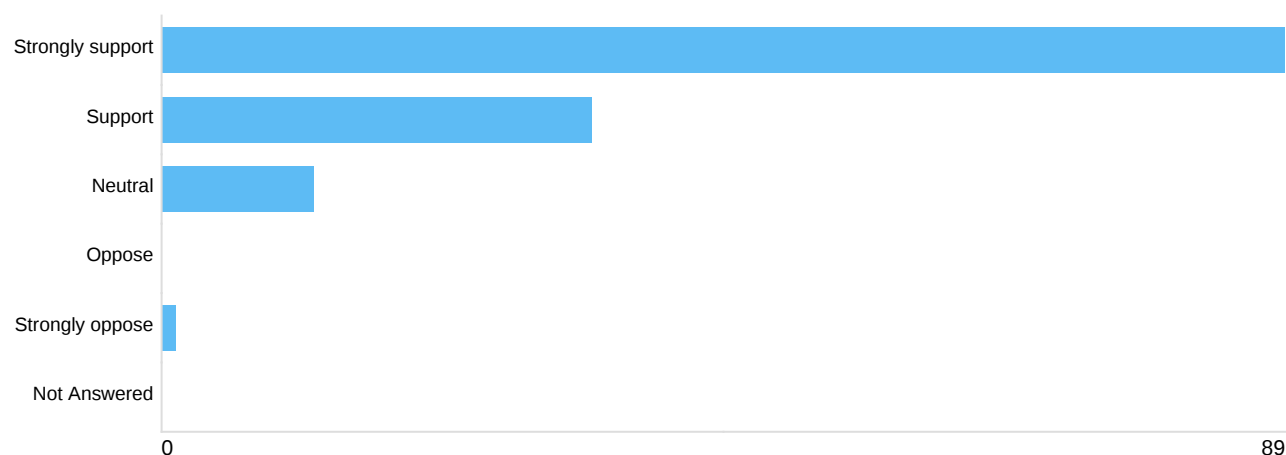

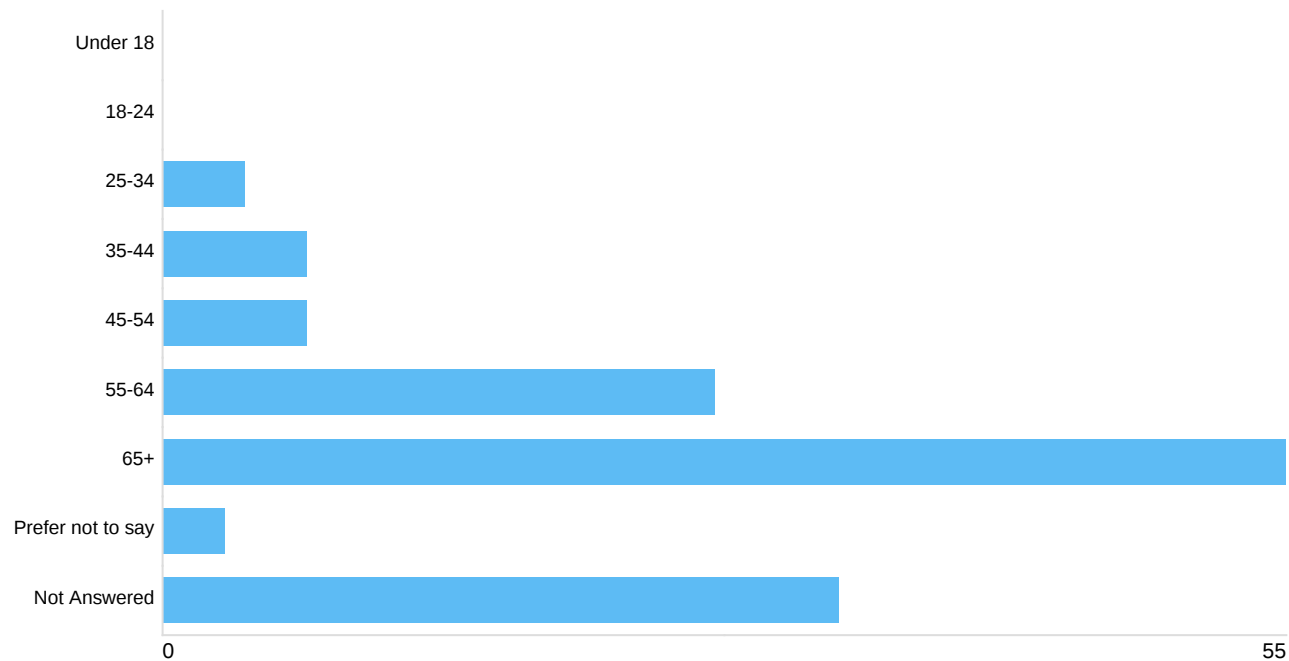
What is your home postcode?

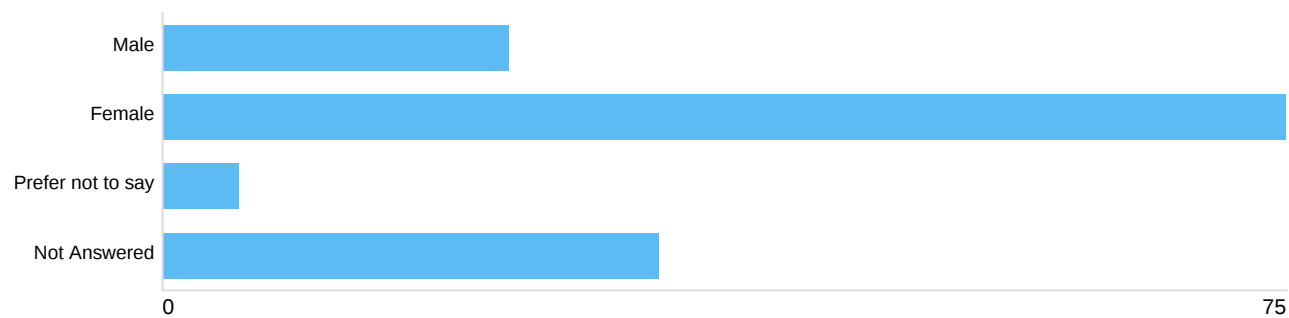

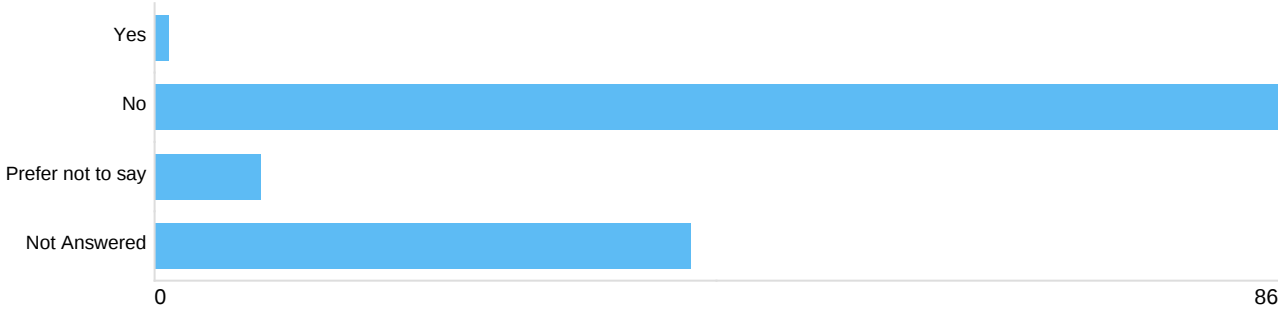

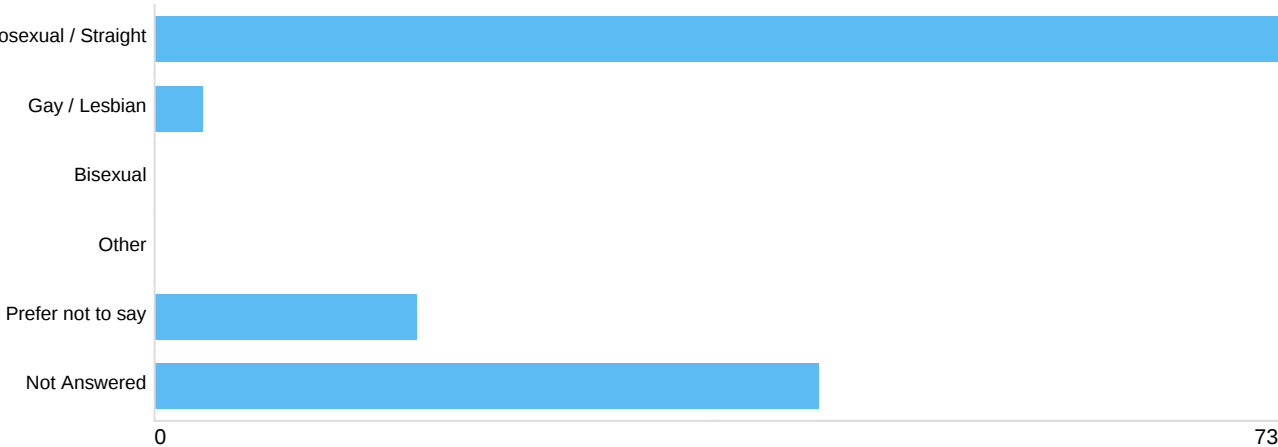

What is your sexual orientation?

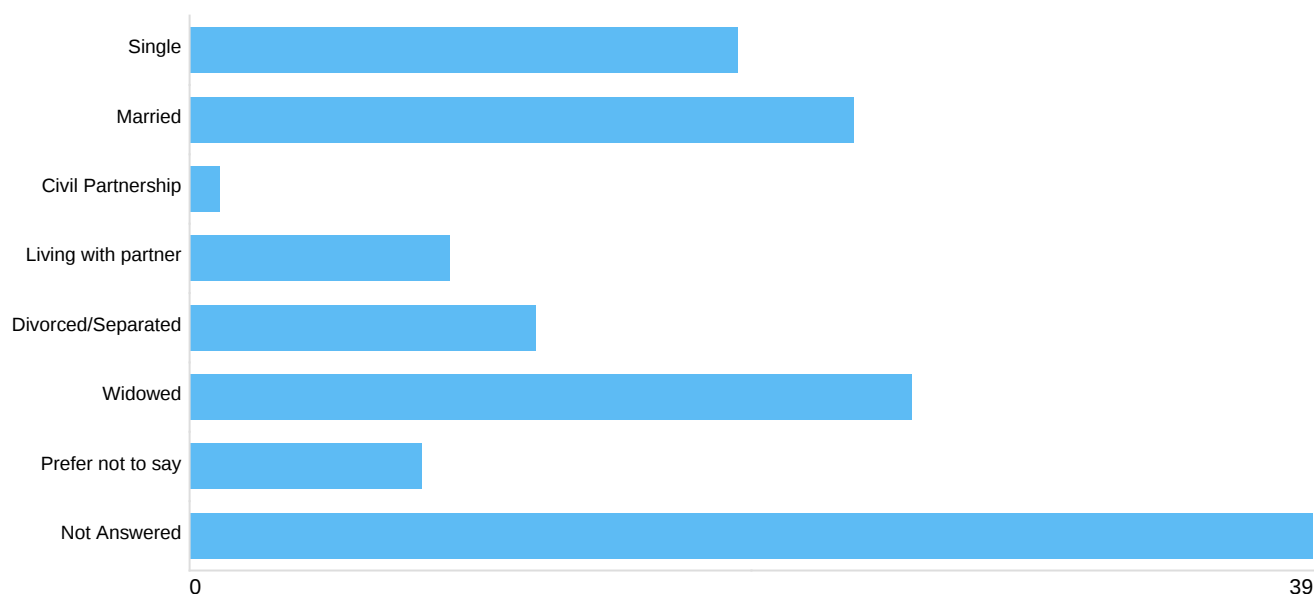
Sexual Orientation

What is your current marital status?

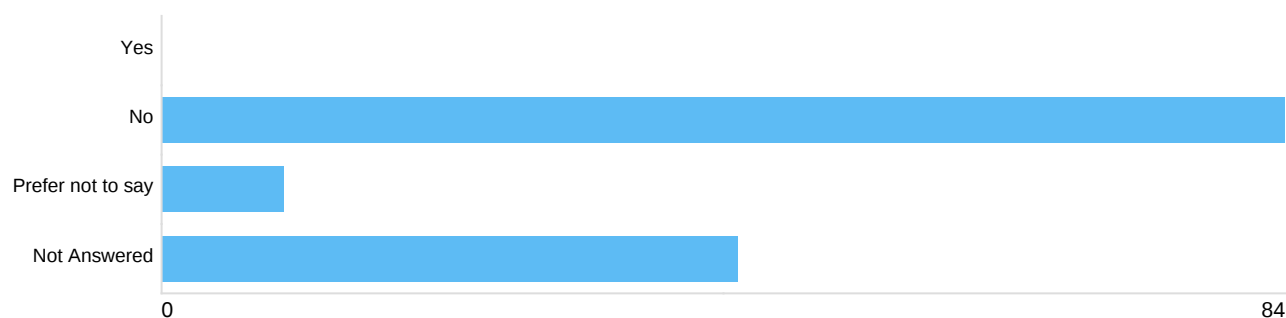

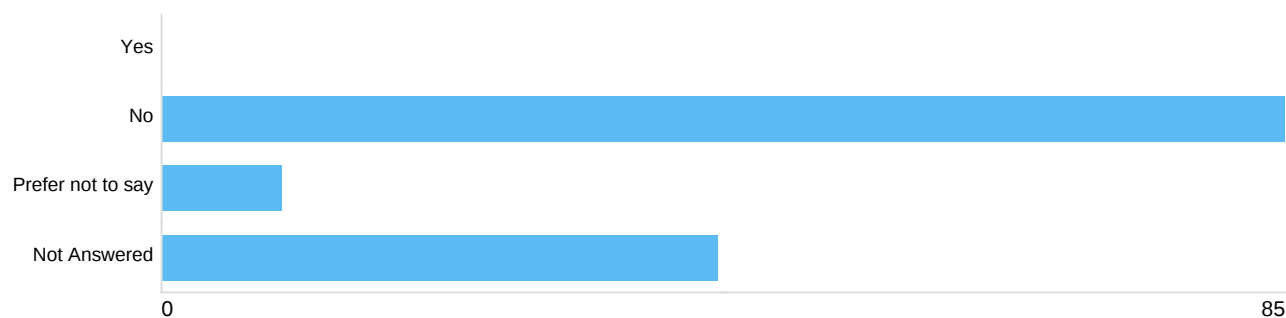

Have you had a baby in the last 12 months?

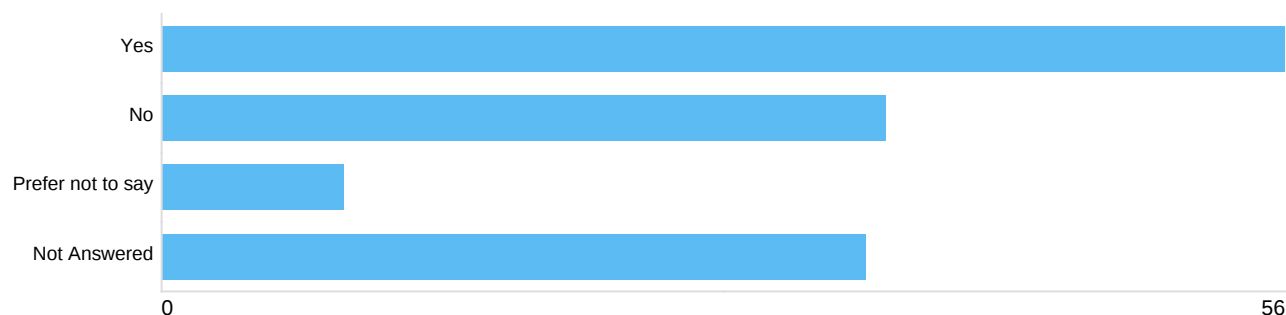
Baby in last 12 months

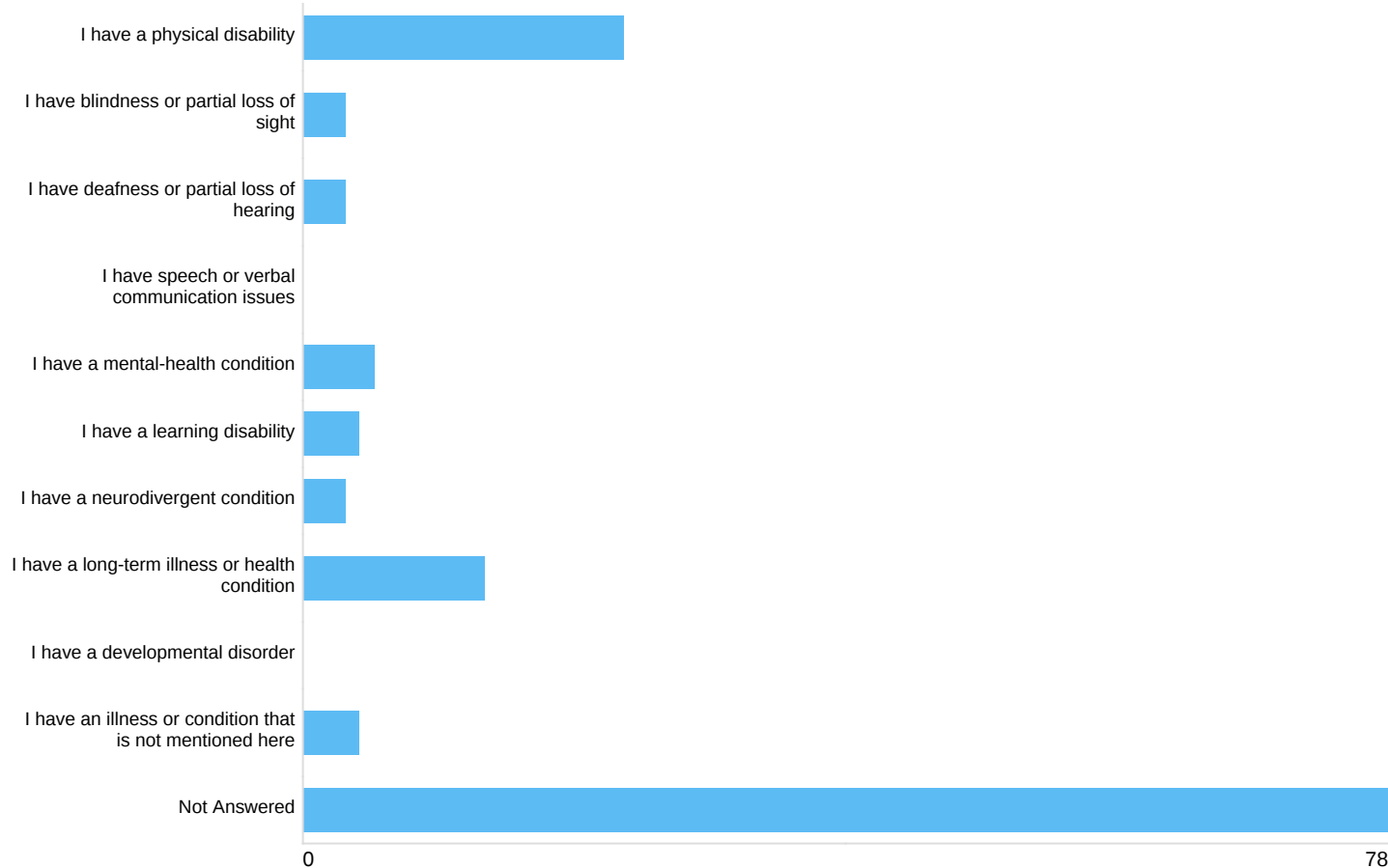

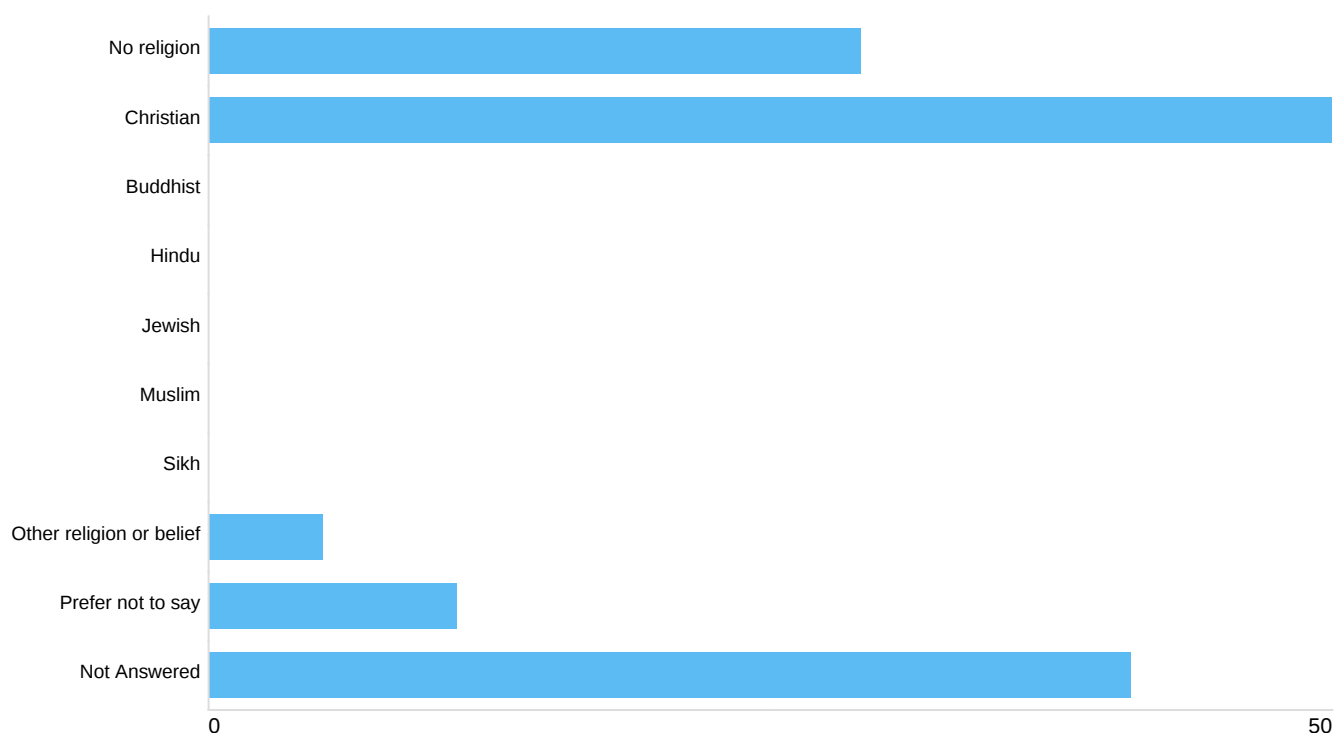

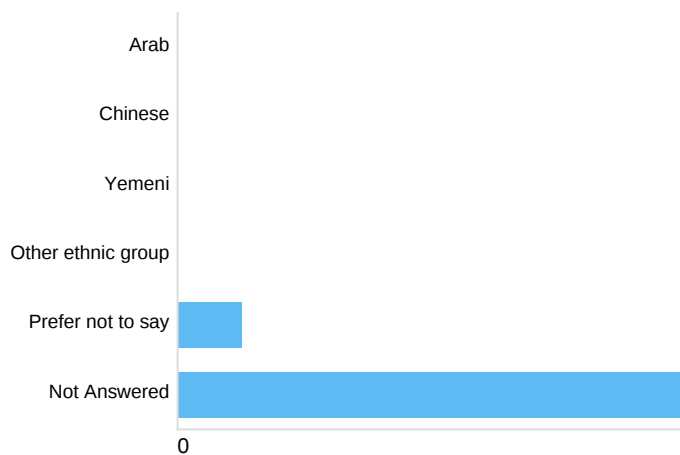
