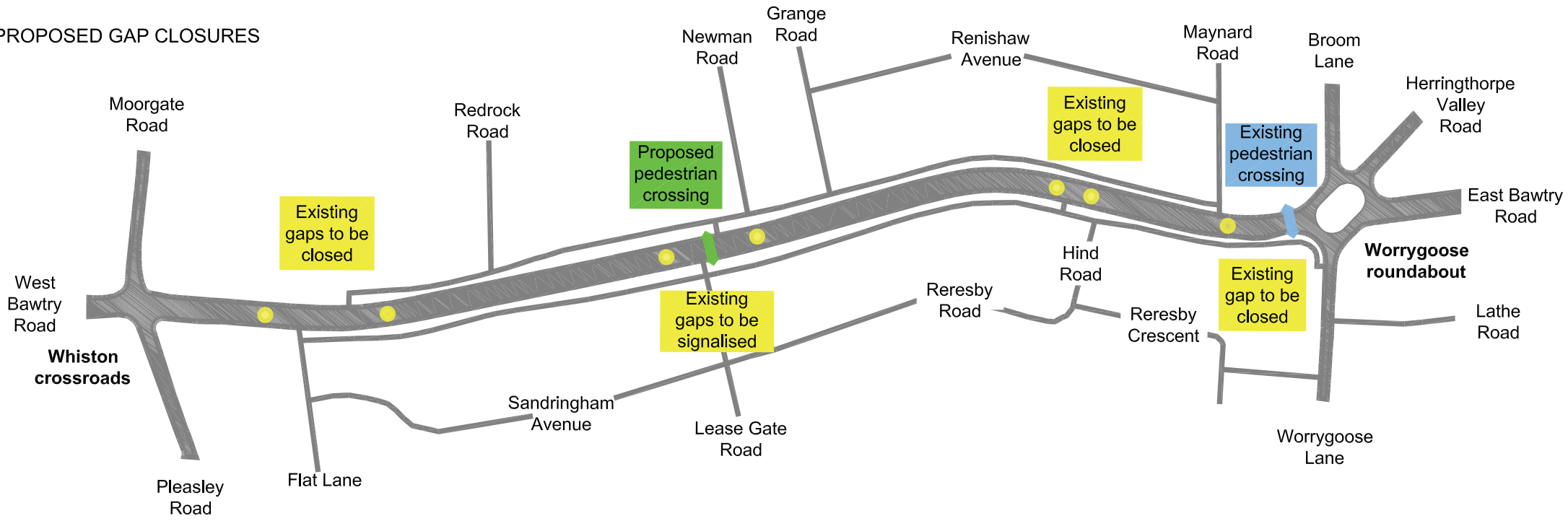
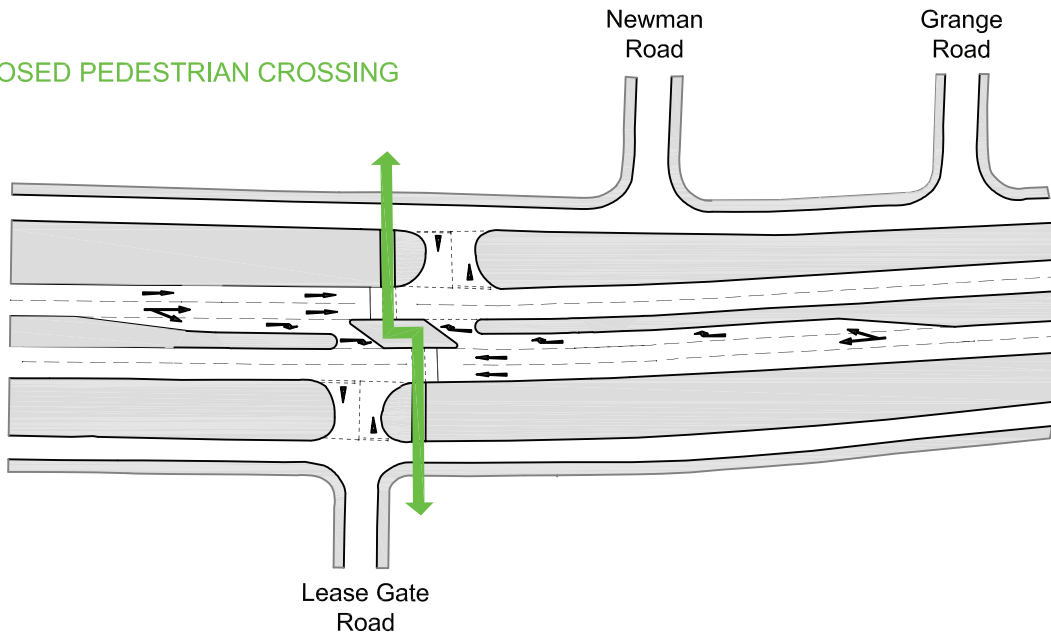


PROPOSED GAP CLOSURES



PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING



The current gaps in the central reserve of East Bawtry Road were put in when the road was not as busy as it is today. Information from South Yorkshire Police indicates that accidents take place at these gaps. In order to improve road safety we propose to close five of the gaps. We also propose to introduce a traffic light controlled pedestrian crossing with signalised right turns to replace the two remaining gaps located near Lease Gate Road.

The formal traffic order consultation for the closure of the gaps commenced on 21 November 2007. The final day for objections to be considered is 4 January 2008.
