# Ageing Well Leadership Academy Programmes

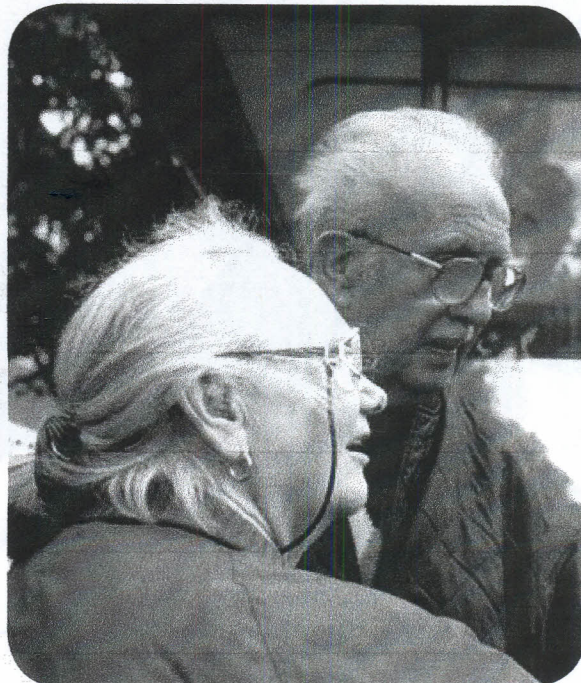

These Leadership Academies look at:

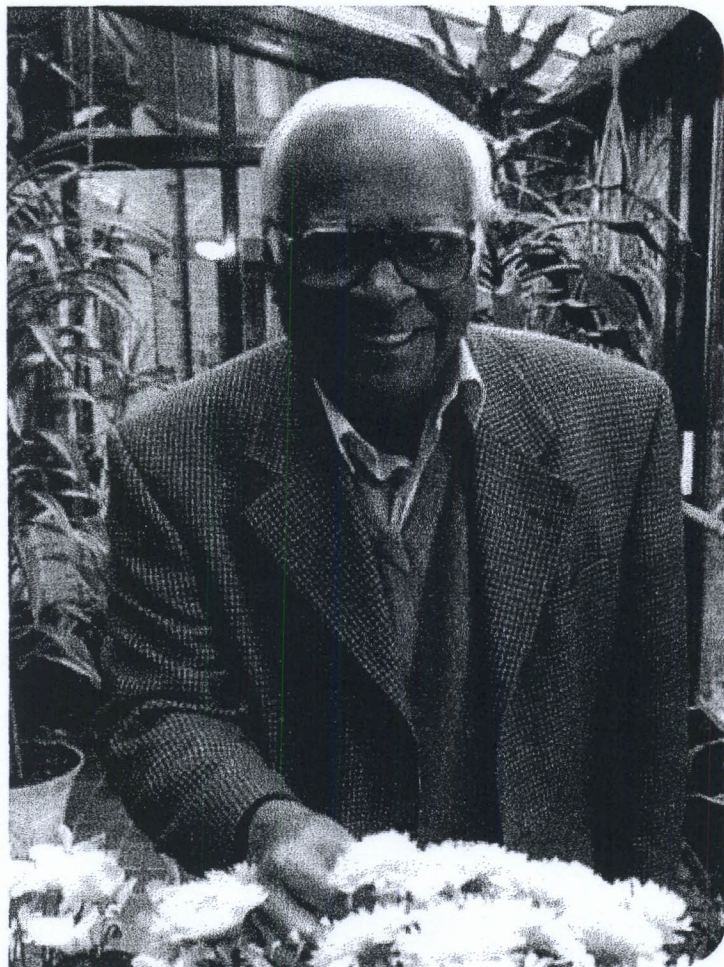
- maximising efficiencies and effectiveness through joined-up and place based approaches
