<p><b>Description:</b></p> <p>Develop and implement a person centred, person held plan, in partnership with key stakeholders.</p> <p><b>Outcome</b></p> <p>Each individual has a single, holistic, co-produced person centred plan, meaning they only need to tell their story once and key details are available (in home and on shared portal initially, building to shared IT capacity) which enables integrated, person-centred service delivery. This approach will transform the way patients with high needs access services and will ensure more joined up working between health and social care.</p>
