## 5. LICENSING ACT 2003 - REVIEW OF PERSONAL ALCOHOL LICENCE

Consideration was given to an application to review a Personal Alcohol Licence in accordance with the provisions of the Licensing Act 2003.

The personal licence holder had been granted the licence on 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2017. However, since the granting of the personal licence she had not acted in the role of Designated Premises Supervisor at any premise in Rotherham although had worked in a number of licensed premises in Sheffield in the capacity of assistant manager.

The licence holder had appeared at Sheffield Magistrates Court on 26<sup>th</sup> June, 2018, where she was convicted of an offence of Common Assault and received a 12 month Probation Order and a Restraining Order preventing her from going near the victim or her family. She was ordered to pay compensation of £200 with an order for £100 costs.

The licence holder had notified the Court that she was the holder of a Personal Alcohol Licence issued by Rotherham Council.

The Sub-Committee gave due consideration to the application to review the Personal Alcohol Licence and the submissions of the various parties at the hearing.

Resolved:- That the Personal Alcohol Licence be suspended for 6 months.
