Question at Council – Wednesday 15th July 2026

Thank you for your question at Council on Wednesday 15th July 2026. I have set out your question and my response below.

Can you confirm the frequency of grass cutting on roundabouts are the same whatever the ward?

I can advise that grass-cutting frequencies on roundabouts are determined by a range of factors, including:

- Highway safety requirements.
- Traffic management considerations.
- The size and nature of the roundabout.
- Seasonal conditions.
- Operational priorities and available resources.

As a result, some roundabouts may be maintained more frequently than others. Whilst many locations receive around five scheduled cuts per season, higher-profile or safety-critical locations may receive additional visits where appropriate.

The Council continually reviews its grounds maintenance programme to ensure that resources are targeted effectively, and that highway safety and environmental standards are maintained across the borough.
